“Doppio Incalmo e Murrina” Vase, Model 351 by Riccardo Licata, Venini Murano, Italy, 1956. An elegant blown glass vase designed by Riccardo Licata for Venini in 1956. This model masterfully combines the doppio incalmo technique—joining separately blown sections of differently coloured glass while hot—with a central band of fused murrine, demonstrating the exceptional craftsmanship of Venini’s master glassmakers. This example features a striking harmony of azure blue, sulphur yellow and deep violet. It is acid-etched “Venini Murano Italia” and retains its original paper label bearing model number 3517, valuable guarantees of its authenticity.
