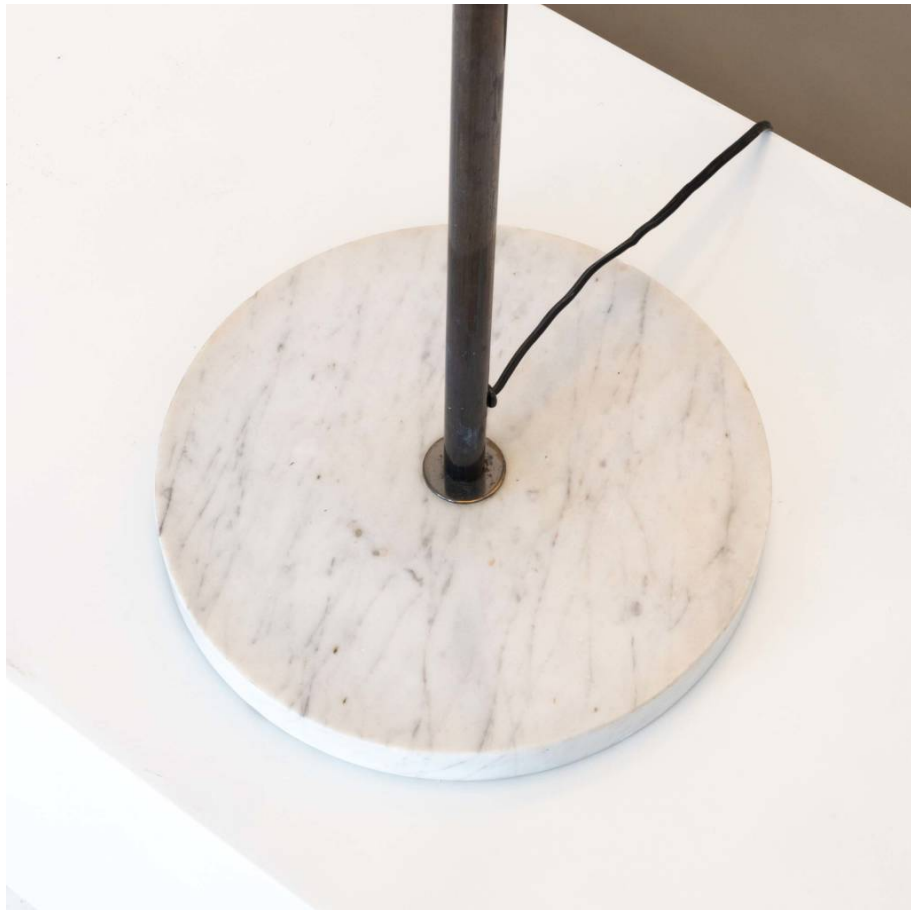
You should know
