About Reine by Line Vautrin

“Reine” Mirror by Line Vautrin (1913–1997), France, circa 1960. Rare “Reine” mirror in beige Talosel, presented here in its large 30 cm version. The convex central mirror is surrounded by a beige Talosel frame, with ivory and subtly browned nuances, richly worked in relief. The border is punctuated with oyster-coloured and pale green mirrored inlays, while twelve spherical elements arranged like a crown are themselves set with a mosaic of small mirrors, each centred by a green mirror. The subtle combination of beige, pearlescent tones and green gives the piece a precious yet organic quality, characteristic of Line Vautrin’s most distinctive creations. “Reine” mirrors are seldom encountered in Line Vautrin’s work, particularly in this large 30 cm size.
