“Occhi” vase by Tobia Scarpa. Quadrangular shaped vase from the occhi series. Made up of an arrangement of white and clear glass murrines and black and clear glass murrines.

You should know

Round "venini murano" acid stamp on the reverse. Paolo Venini And his furnace edited by Marino Barovier and Carla Sonogo, SKIRA p513. Certain Occhi series vases designed by Tobia Scarpa around 1959 take again forms (and an evolution of the technique) imagined by the father, Carlo Scarpa before the war. Similar vase exhibited in the 12th Milan Triennale (1960). A very nice "occhi" from the first period, beautiful shape and superb combination of colors. (model referenced under number 8526). Very good vintage condition.
