About Sfumato by Carlo Nason

“Sfumato” by Carlo Nason, Murano glass floor lamp. Floor lamp by Carlo Nason for Mazzega, composed of a column of seven hand-blown glass modules alternating between clear and opaline finishes. Each segment, shaped using the sfumato technique, creates a softly graduated diffusion that gives the light a gentle and enveloping quality. Topped with a hemispherical dome, this sculptural lamp perfectly embodies Nason’s aesthetic: pure forms, architectural volumes, and a masterful command of Murano glass.
